2017 Face-2-face vs.Online Class Survey

In 2015-16, more than one-half of all enrollments in GBC credit classes were online. In fall 2016, GBC faculty formed an ad hoc Brick and Mortar/Online Committee in order to discuss what this means for student learning and for campus community. Among other information collected, GBC administered this survey in March, 2017, in order to gage student preferences. The survey was administered to 3,103 enrolled students in GBC's service area (after removing those enrolled only in PEX or Driver's Ed classes) and 16% of those surveyed responded.
