MOTIVATIONAL

- Provide the team with the right tools needed to effectively complete the project.
- Assign the right tasks to the right people - what are the strengths of each team member.
- Focus on motivating the team throughout the project to ensure overall happiness and productivity.

ACCOUNTABLE

- The leader needs to be able to carry out tasks and promises made.
- When an error is made, address the error and take responsibility - the team will notice and do the same in the future.

SELECTIVE

- Know the workload that your team can handle - do not weigh down with impossible expectations.
- Refrain from changing plans half way through a project or adding extra duties.
- Use and assign specific tools and resources for success when needed.

SUPPORTIVE

- Do not hover over the team members while they work - monitor the team and trust that they will come to the leader if needed.
- Do not get caught up in minor setbacks - prepare that there will be some and move forward.
- Continue to motivate through positive reinforcement.
- Do not expect perfection - it will not happen.

REALISTIC

- Set reasonable and attainable goals.
- Focus on top priorities.
- Prepare for conflict - address the conflict by problem solving as a team.

SPECIFIC (SMART GOAL)

- S- Specific: The goal should be to improve a specific area or to meet a specific demand.
- M- Measurable: The aim must be measurable or allow for measurable improvement.
- A-Attainable: The goal should be realistic, based on available resources.
- R- Relevant: To be regarded as worthwhile, the purpose should be aligned with other business goals.
- T- Time Bound: The goal must have a deadline or an end date.
