


Great Basin College providing a well lighted pathway






GBC FALL HEADCOUNT & FTE TRENDS




FULL-TIME/PART-TIME HEADCOUNT




GBC Fall Headcount Trends by Race/Ethnicity














2020 Reported Year NSHE Institution Graduation Rates





2020 Reported Year NSHE CC's Institution Graduation Rates





Graduation Rate by Race/Ethnicity Year: 2021 (First-Time/Full-Time degree seeking students)






Great Basin College Fall to Spring Retention First-Time Degree Seeking Students



Number of Degrees and Certificates Awarded




Great Basin College Number of Students Receiving Degrees and Certificates




