2) Overall, six months after graduating, 84% (of those not continuing their studies) are employed and 92% are employed in their chosen field.

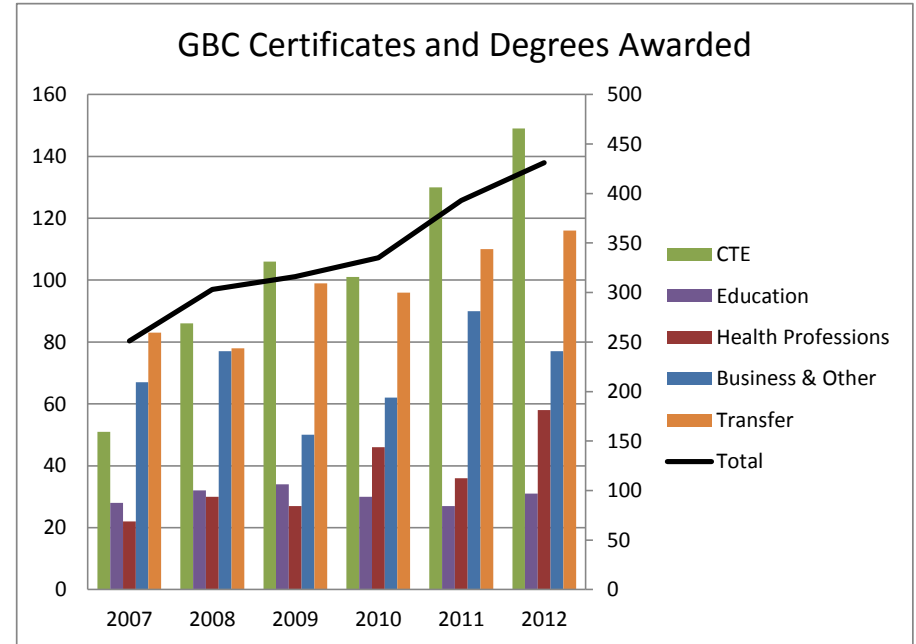
