

Definitions of Terms

<u>TERM</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
<i>Course Enrollment:</i>	The number of students enrolled in a particular course excluding those who dropped. When reported in the aggregate, data may include duplicated counts.
<i>Full-Time Student:</i>	Students who are enrolled in 12 or more units.
<i>Part-Time Student:</i>	Students who are enrolled in less than 12 units.
<i>Successful Course Completion Rate:</i>	Students receiving a letter grade of A to D, or P divided by the total number of students enrolled (excluding students who received NR or I)
<i>Term Retention Rate:</i>	The number of students who completed a semester (term) by receiving a letter grade in at least 0.5 units over the total number of students enrolled.
<i>Fall-to-Spring Persistence Rate:</i>	The percent of new students (unduplicated) enrolled in fall semester, who enrolled in at least 0.5 units in the following Spring semester.
<i>Fall-to-Fall Persistence Rate:</i>	The percent of new students (unduplicated) enrolled in fall semester, who enrolled in at least 0.5 units in the following fall semester.
