





# **Annual Report**

### Independent Audit

The Great Basin College Foundation engaged an independent accounting firm in an audit of its financial statements as of June 30, 2023. In the opinion of the auditor, the financial statements referred to present fairly, in all material respect, the financial position of Great Basin College Foundation.

The Great Basin College Foundation Board of Trustees reviewed and approved the management letter, and audited financials as presented at their meeting of September 21, 2023.

#### Milestones



A consortium of local mining and mining support companies, including Nevada Gold Mines, Pilot Thomas, and Modern Concrete continued to support students in year two of the CDL Class A Training program. Living expense stipends were provided to students participating in this program through the William N. Pennington Foundation.



The William N. Pennington Foundation\* also provided \$325,000 (which includes CDL stipends) in support of GBC's CTE, Paramedic, and the two-year Nursing Programs.

The GBC Foundation held the first annual Great Basin College Foundation Golf Classic in June 2023.



Scholarships totaling \$**750,768** were awarded through our Foundation, a 13.967% increase from the year prior.

### 2023 Fiscal Year Financial Highlights

- Total assets decreased by \$2,066,041 because most contributions for the Winnemucca Health Sciences Building were secured in the prior year and no major giving campaigns were held in FY23.
- Distributions to Great Basin College decreased to \$2,233,613 a decrease of \$4,895,075 from FY22.
- Investment income totaled \$598,953.
- Additions to Foundation Endowments were \$28,737.
- Contributions revenue for FY23 ending are \$1,331,198, which is an increase of \$88,128 over FY22.










The GBC Foundation accepts a generous gift of \$10k from AT&T to develop a dual-enrollment classroom at Battle Mountain High School.
