# SCHOLARSHIPS

## Fall 2012 and Spring 2013

### Great Basin College Scholarship Program

Each semester Great Basin College has a number of scholarships available to award in all program areas. Scholarship award amounts vary. **Financial need for need-based scholarships must be evidenced through the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) process.**

To be considered for the need-based scholarships, we recommend you complete the FAFSA by March 1, 2012. You may apply online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). GBC federal school code is 006977. All scholarships are for GBC attendees unless otherwise specified.

### Continuing Education Scholarships

Applicants for Continuing Education Scholarships must have graduated from GBC with an AA or AS degree and provide proof of enrollment at a transfer institution, or pursuit of a Bachelor degree at Great Basin College.

### Departmental Scholarships

These scholarships are awarded to students pursuing a particular course of study. In some cases, selections are made by the department.

### Disbursement of Scholarship Funds

For the most part, scholarship awards are disbursed in two equal payments upon fall and spring semester enrollment. It is the student's responsibility to meet the required scholarship standards in order to maintain eligibility for the award. Academic Standards require minimum half-time (six credits) enrollment with a cumulative 2.0 G.P.A. unless otherwise specified.

### Attendance Definitions

- Full-time 12 or more credit hours per semester
- Three-quarter time 9 to 11 credits
- Part-time 6 to 8 credits

### Re-Entry Student Definitions

- Students are at least 25 years of age
- Returning to school after an eighteen month or longer break or starting college

**Application forms are available through the Office of Student Financial Services in Berg Hall. An official transcript or copies of an official transcript with a school seal will be accepted (high school, GBC, or transfer). A brief statement of the student's academic, career and personal goals must accompany each application.**
