SCOPE AND CONTENT

Copies of his own original research (compilation of federal archive extractions regarding Western Shoshone communities) were donated to the Great Basin Indian Archives in 2004 and years following by Dr. Crum. The collection consists (2004) of .5 cubic feet of material roughly covering the dates of 1920-1953. There are no restrictions on use of the collection

Arrangement of the collection follows Crum's submitted filing system. Series I is arranged chronologically, community by community and cites the federal collection from which it was obtained. Other series will be added by Dr. Crum at his discretion.
