■ CHAPTER 22 - INDIAN HOSPITALS AND HEALTH FACILITIES

SUBCHAPTER I - MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION

§ 2001. Hospitals and health facilities transferred to Public Health Service; restriction on closing hospitals.
