Living in GBC student housing provides students with many opportunities. Students build friendships in a safe, secure, and clean environment that will enhance their college experience.

Great Basin College's student housing provides convenient, affordable housing for single students, single parents, married students, and married students with children. The resident suites are located across the street from the main campus. Griswold Hall and the apartments for married and family housing are located just two blocks away from the main campus.

Features of Apartment-Style Student Housing

(Resident suites and married and family units)

Full-sized cooking range and oven, Dishwasher. Full-sized, refrigerator, Laundry hookups, Close parking, and lawn area

Single Student Residence Suites

These facilities consist of two-and three-bedroom apartments. Each apartment contains a common living/dining room, kitchen, and bathroom. Students will be sharing an apartment, but will have a private room. Students may request their own roommates, provided all parties are agreeable. Otherwise, the college will assign a roommate based on the information provided on the Student Housing License Agreement.

Costs (includes all utilities and Internet except telephone and cable):
\$1,815.00 per semester \$2,117.52 CTE students

Payment Plans: **Option I:** Housing fees paid in full by the semester "instruction begins" date (see Class Schedule) and receive a \$50.00 discount.

Option II: Four scheduled installments paid each semester as outlined in the housing license agreement.

Married and Family Housing Apartments

Students can choose from two-and three-bedroom apartments. Lawn and playground areas for children are available.

Costs (utilities are not included):
Two-bedroom apartment \$650.00 per month
Three-bedroom apartment \$700.00 per month

Griswold Hall

GBC's newest resident hall provides traditional dorm living for students at an affordable price. Features of Griswold Hall include TV and study rooms, parking, a shared food warming area, lawn and gathering areas, a game room, a well-equipped computer lab, and a laundromat.

Griswold Hall students are assigned a room either single or double occupancy. Each room has a bathroom, however, students will use centrally located shower facilities.

Costs (includes all utilities and Internet except cable TV and telephone):
Regular Semester
Guaranteed private room (per semester) \$1,815.00
Double occupancy room (per semester) \$1,149.52
CTE Extended Semester (48 week occupational program)
Guaranteed private room (per semester) \$2,117.52
Double occupancy room (per semester) \$1,391.52

On-Campus Housing Application Process

- Step 1: Access an application online at www2.gbcnv.edu/housing
- Step 2: Upon receipt, complete the Housing License Agreement, return to the address listed at the bottom of this page with a \$50, non-refundable processing fee plus the applicable deposit of \$200 or \$300.

Frequently Asked Questions

How are roommates assigned?

Preferences for specific roommates are honored whenever possible; each student must request the other on the student housing license agreement form. Assignments are made on a first-come, first served basis. No room assignments are made on the basis of race, religion, color, or creed.

Is there a cleaning deposit?

Yes. Your deposit must be submitted when you turn in your student housing agreement. Griswold Hall has a \$200 deposit, Resident Suites has a \$300 deposit, and Married and Family has a \$300 deposit. Your deposit will be refunded at the end of your contract agreement, provided your room/apartment meets posted checkout standards.

Can I remain in student housing between semesters? Is there a charge for this?

Yes! You may remain in the resident suites and Griswold Hall rooms between the fall and spring semesters for an additional \$100. Additionally, students may arrange to stay in the resident suites during summer sessions. Rates are calculated on a pro-rated basis. Students residing in married and family housing apartments may choose to stay through the summer if they sign a letter of intent to register for the subsequent fall semester. They will continue to pay rent on a monthly basis.

When is student housing available?

Resident suites are available for occupancy one week before the start of classes for each semester. Students will be notified of their move-in date one month before the semester begins. Students who need special arrangements may contact the Housing Coordinator.

Married and Family apartments are available for occupancy as they become vacant.

Are the resident suites and Griswold Hall rooms co-ed?

No. The resident suites will be designated as for women or for men.
