T.J. Stiles is the author of *Custer's Trials: A Life on the Frontier of a New America*, winner of the 2016 Pulitzer Prize for History, and finalist for the Pulitzer Prize for Biography. He also wrote *The First Tycoon: The Epic Life of Cornelius Vanderbilt* and *Jesse James: Last Rebel of the Civil War*. *The First Tycoon* won the 2010 Pulitzer Prize for Biography and the 2009 National Book Award for Nonfiction. It was named a *New York Times* Notable Book and one of the best books of the year by *The New Yorker*, *Boston Globe*, *Christian Science Monitor*, *San Francisco Chronicle*, *Kansas City Star*, and the *Washington Post*.
