Admission/Entrance Exam (TEAS®) is required for all applicants to the GBC Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree. The TEAS® test will be administered four times at GBC. Students may take the test three times per year with at least 40 days between tests. Only the latest test score will be accepted with the nursing application.

Registration Information:

- Go to <u>www.atitesting.com</u> and create a user account. When you submit your application, you will get a user ID and password. Please keep these as they are needed to access the test. The cost of the test is \$95.00. There are additional study packages available through ATI at an additional cost. These can be reviewed on the ATI website.
- 2. Register for TEAS®, chose a State and a City (Nevada/Elko). You will be presented with a list of dates and times. Click on the Learn More button and make sure that you understand the instructions. Please note by clicking the "Register" button you

- agree to test on the selected date. You should also understand that you are responsible for repaying and rescheduling for a new test in the event that you are unable to attend your scheduled date.
- 3. Exams are scheduled at Great Basin College, Elko, Pahrump and Winnemucca. They are also offered at non-NSHE sites, but we strongly urge you to schedule at a GBC or other NSHE location as we ensure optimal testing conditions.
- 4. Applicants may take the TEAS® admission exam up to three times a year, at least 40 days apart, prior to the submission deadline. The most recent TEAS® score will be the only score considered in ranking applicants. It is the sole responsibility of the student to submit a printed copy of the test results with their nursing program application.
- 5. A minimum composite score of 58.7% is required for GBC nursing program application consideration.
- 6. Please arrive at least 15 minutes early to the testing site and present a valid photo ID and ATI user name and password. Calculators are NOT allowed.
