- ▶ File your Application for Admission form with Admissions and Records (Student Services) prior to enrolling.
- ▶ Registration by Internet is available for students who are continuing or who have filed their admission application. Each semester's Class Schedule has directions for access and enrollment on the Internet.
- ▶ Official transcripts from other colleges or high schools should also be on file at Admissions and Records.
- ▶ If you plan to enroll in classes that require reading and mathematics skills, you will be required to take the Placement Test. Check with the Admissions and Records Office for more information. However, if you have completed the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT), you should submit the results with your application.
- ▶ Students confer with advisers about programs, classes, and schedules. If you do not know or have an assigned adviser, call Admissions and Records at 775.753.2102.
- ▶ If you are planning to pursue a bachelor's degree, you should contact the Director of Admissions and Registrar at 775.753.2361. This degree option requires a separate application process and has application deadlines.
