I noticed that students often failed to fully complete discussion requirements. Most often, students did not post the required reply to another student's initial response to discussion questions. Also, students also lowered their discussion scores by failing to cite sources of information on a surprisingly frequent basis. I will address this in the future by placing additional emphasis on full participation, emphasizing the necessity of proper citation of sources, and perhaps developing an assignment focused on when and how to cite sources.
