The difference between quiz scores and exam scores on questions of comparable specificity and difficulty was significant (14.7 percent on chronological sequence questions and 12.2 percent on historical event questions). This can be explained by noting that I required proctoring on exams, but not on quizzes. This difference in results as a result the proctoring requirement indicates significant use of outside sources (notes, books, websites, etc.) while taking the quizzes.</p> <p>Because it is not practical to require proctoring for all brief chapter quizzes, I will consider the replacement of such quizzes with a different type of assignment.
