I feel that I included a few “busy work” questions which will be excluded next semester. Intentionality is key.</p> <p>7 initially enrolled.</p> <p>2 dropped the class.</p> <p>5 student completed the class.</p> <p>5 students received “A’s.”</p> <p>Based on the data, the students met the course outcomes.</p> <p>For future planning, I will limit the essay questions to five or less per assignment. Based on student reports, some of the essay questions will be replaced with student created Power Points, or project-based assignments.</p> <p>The majority of the students completed the quizzes, exams and discussion board assignments in a timely manner. They reported that they liked the</p>
