Survey - Point of contact questionnaire, Accuplacer testing rates, and high school student enrollment. (Active)

Criterion: 90% of seniors and 75% of juniors will complete the Accuplacer test each year. 50% of seniors and 10% of juniors are enrolled in one or more GBC courses. 90% of parents are satisfied with information given on parents night.

Notes: Administer Accuplacer tests to juniors and seniors and recommend placement into math and English classes. Academic advising for other dual credit courses. PeopleSoft query on number of high school students' enrollment and completion. Point of contact questionnaire on understanding of dual credit program. Communicate with school administrators and staff regarding high school packet process for registration. Initiate administration of Accuplacer to juniors. Develop questionnaire.Parents night talk.

Data - Internal tracking of academic advising form completed on every degree-bound high school student every semester to match with high school requirements. Number of associate's degree graduates annually. (Active)

Criterion: Increase by one/year the number of GBC associate degree graduates in the senior class. 100% of all high school seeking degree students are meeting with an adviser each semester.

Notes: Meet with each degree-seeking high school student each semester.

Notes: IRE will provide numbers on students by location. Implement dual credit program with GBC and Lincoln County through communication with school board. Implement academic advising online, phone, and interactive video. Familiarize school staff with GBC's dual credit procedures (high school packet). Develop questionnaire for focus groups.

Internal Tracking - STEM monies pay tuition and book charges for high school students' progression to college mathematics (MATH 120). Students who place into MATH 95, 96, and 97 are eligible for this sponsorship. Internal tracking for students' progression through math courses with subsequent enrollment in MATH 120. (Active)

Criterion: 80% of students in STEM sponsorship math program progress to enrollment in MATH 120. **Notes:** Objective 1.1: Provide educational opportunities through the availability of academic programs, adequately supported focusing on exploring career choices. Process currently in place.
