Operational (Center) - Pahrump Center

GBC Mission: Great Basin College enriches people's lives by providing student-centered post-secondary education to rural Nevada. Educational, cultural, and related economic needs of the multicounty service area are met through programs of university transfer, applied science and technology, business and industry partnerships, developmental education, community service and student support services in conjunction with certificates and associate and select baccalaureate degrees.

Outcome: Quality of support services and IAV support

Faculty and facilitators are satisfied with the quality and range of support services provided for IAV classes.

Assessment Measures

Survey - Survey faculty on levels of satisfaction with: 1) use of equipment by facilitators; 2) their own training on equipment use; 3) on other support services provided for their IAV classes. Survey facilitators on their satisfaction with their own training on equipment use. (Active)

Criterion: 100% are satisfied or very satisfied.

Notes: Work with Center Directors and the IAV Director to develop a simple questionnaire to be given to every faculty member teaching an IAV class fall 2015 and spring 2016.

Survey - Use the Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) and a point of contact questionnaire. (Active)

Criterion: Students are satisfied or very satisfied with available services.

Notes: The next Noel-Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) will be fall 2016. Consider using a point of contact questionnaire to cover services not included in the SSI. The questionnaire should be analyzed for a semester to insure accurate information is being collected. Train staff when to administer the questionnaire and market it to students during the SSI survey.

Data - Track the number of high school students enrolled at GBC-Pahrump and their completion rates. (Active)

Criterion: Increase enrollment of high school students in college-level classes; successful course completion rates (grade C- or better) should be at least at 80%.

Notes: Meet with HS counselors and the principal to produce a strategy to recruit HS students to take college classes. Establish testing days for juniors to see who places into college-level classes.

Notes: Work with the communities in each of the locations to promote GBC. Work with GBC staff to help deliver services to these areas. Work with high schools to develop strategies to get students to take classes.
