## Operational (Acad Affairs) - Library

**GBC Mission:** Great Basin College enriches people's lives by providing student-centered, post-secondary education to rural Nevada. ### Outcome: Collection Management

Review of physical collection of items and review of electronic subscriptions with Faculty input on decisions. With change of 'system' that manages collection, and the process of migrating items in the collection, the library decided to evaluate the collection and make sure that physical items still provide utility to students and faculty. Also, shift to distance and online education has likely contributed to the decline in physical item circulation while increasing electronic item use. Finally, the library and Elko faculty would like to re-purpose the library facility in some way. The first step to re-purposing is a review of the collection.
