Fee Schedule

All tuition fees are subject to change by the Board of Regents:

Note: Notwithstanding currently posted tuition and fees, all fees, tuition, or other charges which students are required to pay each semester are subject to increase by action of the Board of Regents at any time before the commencement of classes (primarily due to budgetary shortfalls). The amount you are charged at the time of registration is not a final bill and may be increased. You will receive a supplemental invoice for any additional amounts which the Board of Regents may impose. Fee changes put in place less than 30 days before commencement of classes will not be subject to late fee penalties.

Technology Fee

\$11.50 per credit - Applies to all GBC courses

In-State Fees (Lower Division)

Course numbers 299 or below \$136.25 per credit

In-State Fees (Upper Division)

Course numbers 300 or above \$226.00 per credit

Dual Credit for High School Students

A postsecondary course taught by an NSHE instructor on the high school campus or NSHE campus through a formally established dual enrollment program. Excludes upper-division courses numbered 300 or above. (ex. ENG 401, PSY 333) \$92.00 per credit, plus technology fee of \$11.50 per credit and any applicable course fees*. *Course/lab fees are variable depending on the course and can be found by searching for the specific course in GBC's class schedule.

Concurrent Enrollment for High School Students

A post secondary course taught at a high school by a high school instructor mutually agreed upon by the NSHE institution and high school. \$110.00 per course, no additional fees.

High School Students who qualify for free or reduced-price lunch

Must be confirmed by school counselor \$62.50 per credit, plus technology fee of \$11.50 per credit and any applicable course fees*. *Course/lab fees are variable depending on the course and can be found by searching for the specific course in GBC's class schedule.

Non-resident Tuition (Enrolled in fewer than 7 credits)

\$149.75 per credit plus the \$136.25 per credit for lower-division courses. \$248.50 per credit plus the \$226.00 per credit for upper-division courses.

Non-resident Tuition (Enrolled in 7 credits or more)

\$4,775.00 out-of-state tuition plus \$136.25 per credit for lower-division courses \$4,775.00 out-of-state tuition plus \$226.00 per credit for upper-division courses

Distance Education Tuition (non-resident students only)

\$68.25 per credit plus the \$136.25 per credit fee for lower-division courses. \$113.25 per credit plus the \$226.00 per credit fee for upper-division courses.

WICHE Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)

\$68.25 per credit plus the \$136.25 per credit fee for lower-division courses. \$113.25 per credit plus the \$226.00 per credit fee for upper-division courses.

Summer Term Tuition

Non-resident tuition will not be charged for courses taken during the summer term.
