High School Registration Fees

Nevada high school students enrolled in GBC classes will only pay 50% of the normal registration and technology fees. Lab fees are variable depending on the course taken and are charged in addition to the registration and technology fees previously mentioned. This special rate is not available for upper-division (i.e., 300- and 400- level) courses or during the summer term.
