

## **COREQUISITE SUPPORT**

#### **ENGLISH PLACEMENT**

If you've taken the ACT, SAT, Smart Balanced, or PARCC testing and scored exceptionally high in the English portion, you may be eligible to be enrolled directly into a gateway English course.

\*\*Placement measures vary by NSHE institution.

#### **PATHWAYS**

#### GENERAL ENGLISH

Students who scored exceptionally high on any of the college readiness assessments listed above will enroll in the general English gateway course, English 101.

#### ENGLISH COREQUISITE COURSE

Students who need additional support will enroll in the English corequisite course, English 100.





## What does Corequisite mean?

A **corequisite** means a course or other requirement that a student must take at the same time as another course or requirement. An advisement recommendation means a condition of enrollment that a student is advised, but not required to meet, before enrolling in a course.



### Corequisite English Placement

Students with relevant standardized test scores will be placed into English classes based on the policy in the NSHE Board of Regents Handbook (Title 4, Chapter 16, Section 1). Students who meet and/or exceed the minimum scores listed below are exempt from any corequisite requirement and will enroll directly into the ENG 101 course:

English College Readiness Standardized Assessment Instruments	
Standardized Assessment Instrument	Minimum Score
ACT English or ACT English Language Arts (ELA)	18 (English) or 20 (ELA)
SAT Critical Reading (SAT Test Date Prior to March 2016)	500
SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (SAT Test Date March 2016 and Later)	480
Smarter Balanced	2583 (Achievement Level 3)
PARCC	Level 4 Score
