The mission of the Teacher Education Program of Great Basin College is to provide a distinctive early childhood, elementary, secondary, and special education program for rural Nevada. The Teacher Education Program is designed to develop competence, values, skills, and knowledge to promote lifelong learning. When you graduate from the Great Basin College Teacher Education Program, you will be prepared for certification by the Nevada Department of Education. You can earn a **Bachelor of Arts Degree** in *Elementary Education*. The Bachelor of Arts in Elementary

Education prepares students to teach grades kindergarten through eight. You can earn a **Bachelor of Arts Degree** in *Secondary Education*. The Bachelor of Arts in Secondary Education prepares students to teach in grades seven through twelve. Endorsement options include mathematics, social science, biological science, English, business education, and career and technical education. Special Education and Teaching English as a Second Language are also endorsement options.

Application Process for CTE College Credit



CTE College Credit promotes students transition from high school to college. High school CTE Completers are eligible to earn free college credit by taking articulated Career and Technical Education courses at their high school to get a jump start on their education. To apply you must complete the application by May 1st!

Complete and submit the online <u>GBC Application for Admission</u>. Complete the online <u>CTE</u> <u>College Credit application</u>. Make sure you select **Great Basin College**. Students can apply for CTE College Credit up to three years after high school graduation. To receive your credits you must complete the requirements for the Nevada Department of Education Certificate of Skill Attainment. Credits are posted to transcripts during the GBC summer semester only.
