The Great Basin College Foundation and Great Basin College are commencing a fundraising campaign for the Welding Lab Expansion project located on the Elko Campus.

Great Basin College and the Foundation recognize the workforce need in rural Nevada for skilled welders and opportunities for industry to enhance the skills of their current workforce. While GBC has a very successful welding program that has served students for over 20 years, we recognize that the facilities are far too small, and in need of major improvements to accommodate the expanding needs of our students and industry.

The estimated cost of the project is \$6.4 million dollars. Of that estimate, Great Basin College has committed a match \$600,000.

The Board of Regents, of the Nevada System of Higher Education, ranked this project as a top priority and we anticipate the 2021 Legislature will provide the funds needed for the Welding Lab Expansion and Renovation.

This expansion will increase the welding shop/classroom space by 4,500 square feet as well as improve student safety and improve ADA access. This project will increase student capacity from 17 to 40 and add new fabrication areas.

Great Basin College has recognized the workforce need in rural Nevada for more skilled welders. While GBC has a very successful welding program that has served students for over 20 years, we have realized that the program itself is far too small, and in need of major improvements to accommodate the growing needs of our area.

These suggested improvements are why Great Basin College has approached the Nevada System of Higher Education for support to renovate and expand our current welding lab. This expansion will increase the welding shop/classroom space by 4,500 square feet as well as improve student safety and additionally include ADA access. Most importantly this project will increase student capacity from 17 to 40.

The estimated cost of the project is \$6.4 million dollars. Of that estimate, Great Basin College has committed a match \$600,000. With building costs rapidly increasing in our area, the time to move on this project is now.

The Nevada Board of Regents added this project as a top priority. Assembly Bill 492 was signed on June 4, 2021authorizing and providing funding for certain projects of capital improvement including the completion of the Welding Lab facilities on the Elko Campus.

We invite you to partner with the Great Basin College Foundation as we work to provide this tremendous opportunity to our students, in hopes of accommodating the ever-growing workforce needs in our area.
