Explanation: These Indians live on the out skirts of Bridge-  
 Port, County Seat of Mono Co., a town of about 250 population.  
 The land and water rights have been absorbed by large Land and  
 Stock Companies, which is used almost entirely for summer range.  
 The village inhabitants do not grow any vegetables. Gardening  
 and farming are not practicable for these Indians. They get  
 labor around the town and ranches.

I find a number of these Indians enrolled  
 at Bishop Agency.
