The following is more information which you requested in regards to TCEP accomplishments.


104 - TRIBAL OFFICE. The tribe is renting an office, rented a copier machine, installed two telephones and bought supplies. The tribe did own one desk, two chairs, one filing cabinet and one large table which were being utilized by ITEC at the Independence office until we established this office. We also were able to borrow a typewriter from one of the tribal members and we also got another desk through surplus.

107 - MEMBERSHIP ROLL. See attached list.

110 - TRIBAL RECORD KEEPING SYSTEM. File folders were set up for the different categories of tribal business and a separate drawer was also set up for the accounting transactions of the tribe. How the files are set up was posted in the front of each drawer.

112(2) - REPORTS. The tribal chairman who also was the project director and the project secretary were the main ones who worked daily in handling most of the tribal business and getting the rough drafts of the ordinances in order to present to the tribal members for their recommendations and approval. Being that the tribe has elected a new chairman and vice chairman in August, 1976, it is quite important that they get acquainted with all aspects of the tribal business. Having a tribal office will also help all the tribal members in getting more acquainted with tribal business because they now can drop in any time during the day.
