A Forest officer was sent to interview Jim Ike on a recent date and he made the statement to the Forest officer that he had been satisfied with the land all the time and that it was one L.F. Clark of Manhattan that talked him into asking him for an additional area. He also stated that the land would be ^{good} no/to him if he did get ^{it}, as he already had all that was of any agricultural value.
