Logging in to GBC Library Databases Using a Non-GBC Device

If you're using your own device (e.g., computer, tablet, or smartphone) to connect to the GBC network, it only has "guest" access. Whether you're connecting through your home Internet service or on the Wi-Fi at a GBC center, you'll need to log in to access Library databases. When you click database links on the Library's website, a login window will open (see example screenshot below), asking for your user name and password. More information about your user name, password, and getting help are provided in the yellow callout boxes below.

Your USER NAME for licensed library resources is your 10-digit student ID number. That number is also your user name on the GBC computer network, myGBC, and WebCampus.

- Your PASSWORD for licensed library resources is the same one for logging in to the GBC computer network.
- However, it might not be the same password you use to access myGBC or WebCampus. These are separate systems, and the passwords could be different, unless you have purposefully made them the same for all of your GBC online resources.
- Your Initial GBC Network Password uses the first three letters of your last name (first letter capitalized) + the first three letters of your first name (first letter capitalized) + the day of the month you were born (if single digit, put zero in front) + last two digits of your birth year. For example, if your name is Megan Reed and you were born on March 6, 1999, your initial network password would be ReeMeg0699.
- **IMPORTANT**: Change your *initial password* as soon as possible.
