

The Kenny C. Guinn Memorial Millennium Scholarship awards \$5,000 each year to four students who are majoring in elementary or secondary education with an intent to teach in Nevada upon graduation. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must have satisfied the eligibility requirements of the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship pursuant to NRS 396.930.
- Must be entering his/her senior or last year of college at an eligible institution.*
- 3. Be enrolled in and remain enrolled in a course of study leading to licensure in elementary or secondary education.
- 4. Maintain a college grade point average of no less than 3.5 on a 4.0 grading scale or a commensurate level of academic achievement provided to and verified by the College Savings Board for students enrolled at an educational institution that does not calculate the grade point average.
- 5. Provide a written statement of commitment to teaching in Nevada upon graduation.
- 6. Have a record of community service.
