MAPE Immunization Requirements

MAPE students are required to start a Complio account through American Databank. Complio accounts are based upon program and location. Please be sure you are following your cohort requirements.

Students are required (once accepted into the MAPE Program) to purchase the MAPE (per cohort) Immunization Tracking, Clinical Rotation, Background Check, and Drug Screening. *See the GBC student guide to Complio and cohort location. http://gbcnvcompliance.com/

Immunizations

MMR- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Immunity

One MMR immunization plus a booster (If born after 1957). Proof of titer immunity is acceptable for all three diseases.

COVID-19 Immunization

Completed series of either two Moderna or Pfizer vaccines. Or one Johnson & Johnson vaccines.

Varicella (Chicken Pox)

Two doses of the varicella vaccine, 4 weeks apart, or positive immunity titer. Influenza Required during flu season (October - March)

Diphtheria/Tetanus Immunization with Pertussis Booster (T-Dap)

Injection must have been received within the last 10 years.

Hepatitis B series

Series of 3 immunization, 1 initially, second with in 1 month, and the 3rd within 6 months recommended. Or 2 dose Heplisav-B, or positive immunity titer.

TB Screening

- A negative TB result is acceptable in one of the following ways:
- Two step TB skin test. First screening completed and ready after 48-72 hours, second screening read after 7 days and before 21 days.
- QuantiFERON Gold Titer test results (must show negative)

- Annual PPD
- TB Skin known to be positive or received the BCG Vaccine, you will need a chest X-ray and clearance letter yearly from a provider.

Additional Requirements

If a student declines, or if the background or drug screening is unsatisfactory to the facility, the student will not be permitted to participate in the clinical portion of the program. Great Basin College is not responsible for obtaining background checks or drug screening and will not receive the results of any investigations. Current students are advised that they will be withdrawn from the program if clinical requirements are not met for any reason

Background checks and drug screening are mandatory for any clinical rotations

 Drug Screening package only be conducted by third party entities. Your Complio guide (per cohort) will have pre-approved collection sites listed under your chain of custody page. GBC is not responsible for obtaining background checks or drug screens, and will not receive the results of any investigations
