GREAT BASIN COLLEGE DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL SONOGRAPHY PROGRAMS ADMISSION SELECTION CRITERIA FALL 2026

Students must complete the certified nursing assistant (CNA) course (NURS 130) or Advanced EMT (EMS 118), or have a current CNA license or AEMT national registry and ALL prerequisite requirements by the end of the 2026 Spring semester to be considered eligible applicants. Eligible applicants will be numerically ranked according to total points received using the selection criteria below. Total points will be determined after Spring 2026 grades have been posted at GBC. Please note that the applicant is responsible for ensuring that official grades for Spring 2026 semester for non-GBC coursework are submitted to the GBC Registrar. Admission will be offered to the applicants with the highest points based on program capacity. Meeting minimum application criteria does not guarantee admission to the program

In the event that applicants have an equal number of points, a tie breaker will be decided based on the grade of one or more of the following courses in the order they appear:

- BIOL 223
- BIOL 224 (only considered if both applicants have the same grade in BIOL 223)
- MATH 126 (only considered if both applicants have the same grade in BIOL 223 and BIOL 224)

Note: the highest grade achieved for courses taken more than once will be used.

If you have tested out of any of the listed General Education courses, or are fulfilling the course requirement with your transferred AS, AA, BS or BA degree, *and* do not provide a grade for the specific course, you will receive 2 points for the course.

Admission/Entrance Exam USA Testing by Pegasus Lectures is required for all applicants to the GBC Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program.

Details:

- 1. The student must sign up and complete the USA test from a personal computer before the application deadline.
- 2. The test can be ordered on the Pegasus Lecture website at: https://pegasuslectures.com/deprecated/product info.php?products id=53089
- 3. The student must cover the cost of the exam which is estimated to be \$75-\$95
- 4. **The USA test is **not compatible** with:
 - Tablet
 - Phone
- 5. Required exam set up:
 - A computer with a screen resolution minimum of 1100×860 is required.
 - Power to your computer or laptop (running from battery is not recommended).
 - Ensure a reliable internet connection.
 - You MUST have a well-functioning mouse and a mouse pad (not a laptop trackpad or other mouse substitute).
 - A functioning video camera.
 - A quiet room in which to take the test.
- 6. Applicants are permitted one exam attempt within a given application cycle. A reapplicant has the option to retake the exam once in a new application cycle.
- 7. The total number of allowed attempts is limited to a maximum of two.
- 8. The exam will take approximately 2.5 hours.
- 9. Question types vary.
- 10. This is an aptitude test. It cannot be studied for.
