The Curriculum and Articulation Committee met on Tuesday, September 3, 2014. The committee requests faculty senate action on the following items:

1. IT 209B course approval (new course/reactivation)

IT 209B Rigging has been offered in the past (as recently as 2010). However, since that time rigging has covered as part of another class. The class is being reactivated to meet industry certification standards. The committee approved the course articulation request by a unanimous vote.

2. PEX 149 course approval (new course)

Zumba has been taught as PEX 170 Aerobics. Adding the course as PEX 149 will bring GBC in line with the common course numbering and make it easier to list and find in the catalog. The committee approved the course articulation request by unanimous vote.
