GBC has offered CNA classes at the following locations with varying schedules trying to accommodate as many students as possible:

Classes in Pahrump, Winnemucca, Elko, and Lovelock

Program Issues:

Elko – Kandis Bockness and Sarah Crabtree have offered two Spring Courses. Sarah Lino will teach the July course. Kandis will also teach the first fall mini session course. I am recruiting an instructor to teach the late fall course.

Ely – Jill De Steunder’s spring class was cancelled for low enrollment. I have not been able to get a summer schedule from Jill. Rocky Jones is the school nurse in Ely and teaches CNA at the high school. She has agreed to teach a summer course for GBC and is completing paperwork now. We currently have four students interested in enrolling.

Winnemucca – Continues to have steady enrollment about 10 students per semester. Stacy Rust has completed CNA instructor certification and will now offer testing in Winnemucca. The first date for skills testing will be in July.

Battle Mountain – Did not have a spring course this year. Planning to offer fall course, Suzanne Rowan will be the instructor.

Pahrump – Continues to have steady enrollment with 15 students per course and three courses annually. The CNA students in Pahrump will now share the lab with the ADN students there. A significant amount of overstocked CNA supplies are being relocated to other campus

locations. I'm hopeful the new instructor for the ADN program in Pahrump will be willing to offer testing at that location as well.

Lovelock- Initial CNA course is going well. We got a total of 12 students. I've had several calls from potential students wanting the dates for the next course. Instructors in Lovelock are planning for fall, and possibly a summer course. Minor issue of not having enough clinical space to accommodate 12 students. The instructors provided 2 sections of clinical time.
