Current chairs vary from desk chairs, stackable chairs, along with other styles, heights, and colors. All are extremely old and show signs of stain and wear and students can feel the bolts when sitting down. The legs on some chairs are uneven which creates angled seating. Chair legs have lost steel pads on bottom making it impossible to move the chair without damaging carpet. Many of our students are larger men. A majority of chairs are built with no leg supports. These chair legs bend out with additional weight, thus creating a safety issue. Recent student evaluations also showed that students were uncomfortable sitting in the current chairs in the HSHS building. This is an indication that physical resources are currently not sufficient to ensure the achievement of the student learning outcomes and program outcomes of the Health Sciences and Human Services programs. Additionally, other GBC departments use these classrooms again affecting student learning in these various departments. Students can spend hours a day in the classroom. Having a space that allows students to learn comfortably can help students remain focused and engaged. The HSHS department does not have the funds to purchase new chairs for the building and is requesting funding from the Budget and Facilities Committee to equip the classrooms with new chairs for students.
