A. President DeMarynee Sali discussed current SGA events and her current activities as SGA President.

- She said sit has been a busy week and she thanked the candidates for running.
- She said she gave them the idea about a discount for international travel to all students, and not just Elko alumni students. She recommended that people should sign up to be an Alumni at graduation. She also gave the Alumni Task Force the idea to do a photo booth at graduation. She mentioned that Kayla McCarson is also part of the Task Force and she is a Social Media Specialist, and hopes that there might be a photo booth station this year. The election events were a success and that there are only three weeks of school left. She had an Alumni Task Force meeting, and they talked about the benefits students will get after graduation. - Student Advocate, Adriana Mendez, announced the winners for the SGA Elections.


