7. STUDENT ADVOCATE'S REPORT

INFORMATION

- Welcome Back activities Welcome Bags were created rather than traditional food-based activities.
 Bags included hand sanitizer, lens wipes, masks, GBC branded giveaways, Chapstick, prepackaged fruit snacks and mints, and stress balls. This event was for students at the Elko, Pahrump, Ely, and Winnemucca Centers. Center Director Veronica will be submitting a reimbursement as she had a \$50 budget to begin with.
- Virtual Meet and Greet Date of 9/10/2020 Students will participate in a "Get-to-Know You" event via Zoom in conjunction with GBC Housing. Testing out JackBox is in the works, Ryan and Chantell are working on coming up with an event.
- Update on Senator positions Student Advocate Garcia read Senator Gisselle Esparza's resignation letter. Four Elko Senator positions will be mitigated to Online Senator positions as about 85% are online students. In the future, Online Senators will be responsible for online/virtual events. The consensus was that Officers thought the idea was a great way to include more of the student population. Senator Dempsey asked about the scholarship amount, Chantell will follow up with Sonja. The SGA application and fall election calendar are live. Previous Senators are currently considering Executive positions. Student Advocate Garcia encouraged Officers to reach out to students who may be interested in participating and reminded everyone that the scholarship amount has gone up.
- Choose Fall 2020 meeting time After a brief discussion of schedules, Officers concluded that Fridays
 at 3 PM is the best time to meet. Future meetings will be scheduled for Fridays at 3 PM, Zoom will be
 used for the time being.
- Game Room A discussion about adding a vintage style arcade game and a LED welcome sign to the
 Elko Game Room. Stephen Theriault asked if there were cameras in the game room Student Advocate
 Garcia said that there were two functional cameras. Steve suggested that a survey be given to gauge
 interest. Vice President Stevens had previously completed a survey and had little participation. VP
 Stevens discussed that it may be a large expense for not having many students currently on campus.
 Student Advocate Garcia showed what the arcade machine was via screenshare. Senator Sturges
 suggested that the topic be revisited after seeing how many students utilized the game room and

- discuss it in the next semester. Student Advocate Garcia will work on seeking donations. Stephen Theriault suggested reaching out to Russ Minter.
