She is planning a Halloween-themed drive-in movie event for October. Movie suggestions are welcome from the officers but should be kept to a PG-13 or lower rating.
- The SGA application ad went live on WebCampus on Monday, and a text message went out Thursday. There is an excess of applications for both Elko and online senators, as well as a couple other center applications. She has been meeting with applicants to discuss SGA and has also been inviting them to participate in SGA meetings.
- She facilitated a leadership activity centered around Angela Duckworth's TEDx Talk on 'grit'. Everyone took turns explaining what 'grit' means to them and how they have shown 'grit' in their own lives.
